Create a long-term plan for the maintenance and potential expansion of the entire trail system. Any potential expansion must remain cognizant of the natural surroundings and consider the impacts of climate change.

Plan for and execute trail remediation and repair on an annual basis based on the condition of trails at the end of the season, the needs of the membership and the financial resources available.	Create a volunteer engagement plan that focuses on membership attraction, engagement, and retention with an emphasis on young skiers, families, and seniors.	Assess, and if feasible, increase the capacity of the snowshoe trails to provide links and opportunities for snowshoeing and hiking.
Ensure adequate financial resources and volunteer labour are made available to maintain the trails.	Support the development of opportunities to build relationships between and amongst club members in order to enhance the membership experience.	Assess, and if feasible, increase our ski trails to accommodate the membership.
Ensure the maintenance and development of the current and future trails is focused on the attraction and retention of members.
